Website statement concerning biometric data



Having a Protection of Biometric Data Policy is a statutory requirement only if schools are processing biometric data. Schools that do not process biometric data should publish a statement outlining this on their websites.

Please put the following wording on the webpage in the tab you have for data protection so that it can be seen alongside the link to the Trust's data protection information.

This statement confirms that, at Ivy Bank Primary School, we do not store or process any form of biometric data, such as fingerprints or retina scans.

The Board of Trustees and data protection officer (DPO) will review this statement on at least an annual basis. The next scheduled review date for this statement is Autumn Term 2025.

If the school does decide to store or process biometric data, a policy will be implemented for the processing of such data, which would be made available on the school website. Any changes made to the school's position on the processing of biometric data will be clearly communicated to all staff, parents and pupils.
